GOOD TO KNOW

The house mosquito is not yet dangerous, but particularly irritating. However, the house mosquito is indeed able to transmit the West Nile virus. Birds in the Netherlands may already be infected with this.

MOSQUITOES ARE ATTRACTED BY ODOURS

Mosquitoes are attracted by odours and have a very refined sense of smell. As a result, they will notice us at tens of metres, even at 30 to 50 meters away!

MOSQUITO SALIVA

Your immune system can react violently to the **20 foreign substances** that a mosquito can transmit with a bite.

X Eating garlic

LIFE CYCLE A mosquito needs blood to reproduce.



PREVENTION

REDUCE BREEDING SITES

Drain stagnant water (breeding ground)

CREATE BARRIERS

Provide a mosquito-free (bed)room: install insect screens in window and doorframes.

MOSQUITO NET

Hang a mosquito net above your bed (use an impregnated net in malaria areas).

CLOTHING


Wear covering, airy and light-coloured clothing as much as possible.


MOSQUITO REPELLENT

Treat uncovered skin with a mosquito repellent.

DEET PROTECTION

DEET also protects against ticks, but only half of the time it is active against mosquitoes.






THE TIGER MOSQUITO



In contrast to the malaria mosquito, the tiger mosquito bites during the day!

The tiger mosquito has a strong preference for human blood and is the carrier of more than 20 viruses. You can get sick after one bite!

THE MALARIA MOSQUITO


The malaria mosquito is active between sunset and sunrise.

This mosquito transmits malaria after it has bitten a patient and is infected itself.



247.000.000 MALARIA INFECTIONS IN 2019

- Approx. 619.000 cases have a fatal outcome.
- Malaria Tropica is the most dangerous form and can, without treatment, be fatal within a few days
